The college situated in 14-Goalpara East Legislative Assembly Constituency and located in the vicinity of Krishnai just 1 K.M. South from the N.H.37 was affiliated to Gauhati University in 1983 and was placed under deficit system of Grants-in-Aid w. e. f. 01-02-1986. The college has got permanent affiliation and has been registered under 2 (f) & 12 (B) of UGC act 1956 w. e. f. March, 2006.

The college has been offering Two Year Higher Secondary Course and Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) in the faculty of Arts with Major in Assamese, Arabic, English, Economics, Education, Political Science, History. Admission Procedure HS FIRST YEAR

The admission process of the college is completely online based. Hence, for the purpose of application for admission into the college the applicant should have to login to the DARPAN Portal by visiting www.darpan.ahseconline.in or www.ahsec.assam.gov.in and the concerned students have to go through the guidelines/SOP given by AHSEC.

Some important points to be noted for Admission

- (A) Applicants can download the college prospectus from the college website www.habraghatcollege.in.
- (B) Admission is done in order of merit as per admission rules after due scrutiny of the relevant documents by the admission committee.
Applicant will have to produce the following documents in original at the time of admission.

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- i) Mark sheet and admit card of the last qualifying examination.
 - ii) Pass certificate from the concerned authority.
 - iii) Caste certificate (wherever necessary) from the component authority.
 - iv) In case of any gap in admission, a Gap Certificate from the head of the institution attended last should be submitted.
 - v) In case of students from other state should have to submit migration certificate in original.
 - vi) Income certificate issued by the concern authority for free waiver category.
- (C) All the applicants are advised to keep their User ID, Password, Registered mobile number & registered email ID in safe custody for the purpose of future use.

FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYUGP) UNDER NEP (BA 1st SEMESTER)

The applicants should register themselves into the SAMARTH Portal by visiting <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>. The candidates need to select their desired institution through the portal and upload necessary documents required for the admission procedure.

After Registration the applicant will receive user ID & password. After getting the user ID and password the applicant should have to login to the Samarth portal and have to select the desired college and fill-up the admission form and submit it online along with necessary document as per requirement of the portal, such as Marks Sheet, Pass Certificate, Caste Certificate, Registration Certificate, Gap Certificate/Affidavit, Migration Certificate, Income certificate issued by the concern authority for free waiver category, etc. within the stipulated date & time.

After obtaining online admission application form from the applicants, the college will verify the applications and publish the list of candidates according to merit depending upon the availability of seats for different classes.

After publication of the list of selected candidates for admission into the college, the selected candidate will receive a message in his/her registered mobile no. After getting the message from the college the selected candidate should have to once again login to the admission portal with his/her own User ID & Password and proceed for completion of the process of online admission within the stipulated date & time fixed by the college for admission.

SPECIAL NOTE:

- During registration all the candidates are asked to provide their own active mobile no and email ID. Candidates shall not be allowed to change their registered mobile no and e-mail ID till the completion of the course.
- The selected candidates should have to ensure their online admission within the dates fixed for admission by the college without fail, failing of which will forfeit their claim for admission into the college.
- All the applicants are advised to keep their User ID, Password, Registered mobile number & registered email ID in safe custody for the purpose of future use.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

(A) Admission to H.S. Courses:

(i) A student seeking admission into Higher Secondary First Year must have passed HSLC Examination conducted by SEBA/ CBSE or any other equivalent examinations conducted by recognized Board or council.

(ii) A student seeking admission into Higher Secondary Second Year must have passed the H. S. First Year Examination.

Admission into Four Years Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP):

(i) A student seeking admission into B.A. first semester must have passed 10+2 final examination as conducted by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council or any other Board or Council.

Internal Examination and Evaluation for H.S. Course:

In order to prepare the students for the external examinations conducted by AHSEC and with a view to getting necessary feedback, the college conducts the following internal evaluation by the Internal Examination Board of the college as well as the respective departments:

(A) Unit Test: In each academic session there will be two Unit Tests for 20 Marks each to be conducted by respective department as per schedule to be announced in advance. Attendance in the Unit Test is compulsory.

(B) Projects and viva: The internal evaluation includes project work and viva voce conducted by respective departments as per the requirements.

(C) Test Examination: The Internal Examination Board of the college will conduct test examinations which will be treated as qualifying examination for appearing in the final Examinations.

FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME UNDER NEP (FYUGP)

The undergraduate degree (UG) programme in the “Four Year Under Graduate Programme” (FYUGP) is a Choice Based Credit System under Semester Scheme. The candidate has an option to exit after completion of 2nd/4th/6th Semesters of the programme (at the end of each academic year) and shall be awarded Certificate, Diploma, and Undergraduate degree with Major/Minor respectively.

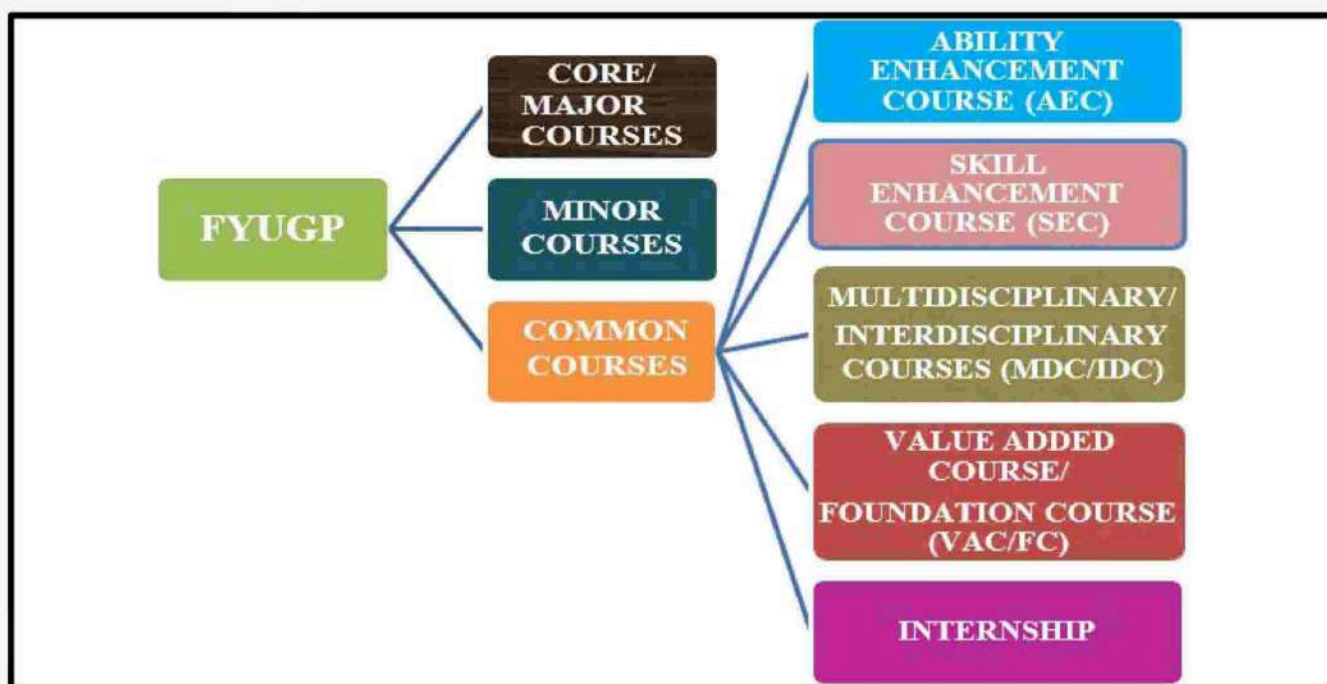
Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semesters will make up an academic year. UG course shall be of eight semesters covering four Calendar Years (Academic Sessions – July to June). The duration of the Odd Semesters (First, Third, Fifth and Seventh) shall be July - December, and that of Even Semesters (Second, Fourth, Sixth and Eight) shall be January - June. Each student must take admission in four consecutive academic sessions starting with the first semester. Students who do not enroll in the second academic session will not be eligible to take admission in the third academic session and fourth academic session respectively. Similarly, a student who do not enroll in the third academic session will not be eligible to take admission in the fourth academic session.

The programme permits horizontal mobility in course selections for the students. They may pursue the three years or six semester programme within 5 years and four years or eight semester programme within 7 years. The programme allows the students to re-enter the course within a time of 3 years.

CREDIT AND ATTENDANCE:

Credit is to be earned by the students in full and not in fraction

Gauhati University set minimum 75% attendance in class as the requirement to earn full credit.

Without 75% attendance, the students will be debarred from attending in End Semester Examination.

The debarred students will continue their studies till final semester.

After completion of attending the others External Semester Examination (ESE)s, the debarred students will have to attend the classes to earn the required credits for the debarred semester.

Only then, they will be allowed to appear in both Internal as well as the External Semester Examination of debarred semester.

Internal Assessment will ideally account for 40% of the total marks allotted to a course / paper.

Medium of Instruction:

The medium of instruction in all subjects is English and Assamese.

General Rules for Maintenance of Discipline among Students:

- (A) The college authority strictly adheres to the rules and regulation of the college for maintenance of discipline among the students. Every student is expected to abide by the rules and regulations as prescribed by the college.
- (B) A student to be eligible for appearing in the Council/University examination must attend 75% of the total lectures delivered in each subject/paper during the academic session. Unsatisfactory progress report will disqualify him/her to appear in the finals.
- (C) All forms of ragging in the college campus is strictly prohibited. Strong disciplinary action as deemed fit by the Vigilance Committee, may be taken if anyone found to be involved directly or indirectly in ragging.
- (D) Student's Union or any other Association shall be subject to the rules and regulation of the college administration.

- (E) The students must keep away from drugs, drinks and such other activities as detrimental to the ever flourishing academic atmosphere of the college.
- (F) Violation of any of the above mentioned condition will make a student liable for punishment such as termination of scholarship, rustication, expulsion etc.
- (G) All power of maintenance of discipline is vested with the Head of the institution.

Identity Card & College Uniform:

Every student should have his/her non-transferable I-cards duly endorsed by the principal. No student will be allowed to attend classes without the college uniforms as prescribed by the college authority.

Awards & Scholarship:

Apart from SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/Merit Scholarships by State & the Central Govt, the college with a view to encourage meritorious students in their pursuit for Excellency, awards free-studentship for one year term to the students securing highest marks (not less than 70%) in the last qualifying examination provided he /she belongs to BPL.

Library Facility:

The central library of the college is enriched with a stock of 16800+ books. Besides there are a good number of magazines and journals subscribed regularly for the benefit of the students. There is also internet facilities for the teachers and students for accessing electronic resources. The library of the college accommodated with the reading room facilities for the teachers and students, remains open during the working hours of the college. The students are allowed to borrow books through their library cards to be collected from the librarian. Borrowers must return the books within the specified time and are personally responsible for the loss or damage of any book borrowed.

Students' Union & Co-curricular Activities:

Habraghat Mahavidyalaya Students' Union (HMVSU) is the general body of the students of the college. The office bearers of the union are democratically elected for one year term. To promote all-round development of the students and to inculcate a social sense in the minds of the students, the Union Body with active co-operation of the teachers in-charge organizes various co-curricular activities and competitions mainly in games & sports, debates, cultural items, social service, literary competition etc. among the students. The Union also publishes College Magazine and Wall Magazine as a medium for developing literary potentialities of the students.

N.S.S. Unit:

The college has a National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit under the guidance of a trained Programme Officer to provide opportunities to the students not only to develop personality but also to serve the society while carrying out various welfare programmes.

Counselling and Career Guidance Cell:

There is a Counselling and Career Guidance Cell in the college to help the student in providing necessary information and guidance leading to their promising future.

Special Award to Meritorious Students:

With a view to encouraging the meritorious students who have acquired excellence in the H.S. & B.A. Final Examinations Conducted by AHSEC and GU, the College has introduced the following awards in cash with effect from 2010.

- i) Award of Rs. 5000.00 (five thousand) only each to the top five students of UG Programme.
- ii) Award of Rs. 4000.00 (four thousand) only each to the students securing 80% marks in the H.S. final examination.
- iii) Award of Rs. 3000.00 (three thousand) only each to the students securing 75% marks in the H.S. final examination.
